UNIFORM - I would like to remind all students that they are required to wear school uniform every day. You should have a hoodie and 2 polo shirts for your child. These are provided free of charge for every full-time student. Part-time students receive 1 polo shirt. If your child loses their uniform we will provide another, but are required to charge you for this.



BREAKFAST - All students are provided with breakfast and lunch as part of their package at SSPS. A member of staff in your child's Centre will go through menus with the group so that students know what to expect. Please do not allow your child to bring unhealthy snacks or drinks to school, healthy snacks and water are provided.
