

SSPS Outcomes 2017

Attainment:

14% of students achieved 5+ L2 including English and Maths (3/22)
23% of students achieved Grades 4-9 in English and Maths (5/22)
55% of students achieved at least one Level 2 qualification (12/22)
86% of students achieved Level 1 qualifications in English and Maths (19/22)
100% of those assessed made the minimum 10% increase in Thrive
96% of students in Year 11 have a secure post 16 destination (23/24)

Progress:

At SSPS we know that many of our students join us with disrupted educational histories, therefore all student complete baseline testing on arrival and progress is measured from this starting point.

In English 70% of students made progress from their baseline (14/22) . 50% of students achieved G3 (D equiv) or better. This equates to outstanding progress , when compared with academic year 15/16 and is in line with Complex PRU's nationally.
In Maths 58% of students made progress from their baseline (12/22) , this is in line with that seen in Complex PRU's nationally.
In Science 59% of students made progress from their baseline (13/22) . This equates to good progress when compared with academic year 15/16 and is in line with Complex PRU's nationally.

Other Successes:
