Remote or face to face Thrive assessments

We are able to complete THRIVE assessments remotely, if requested. We will also be starting face to face meetings where applicable.

SEMH newsletter

A half-termly SEMH newsletter will be emailed to our partnership schools, as requested. This supports staff by signposting agencies and relevant resources. *Please let us know if you wish to be added to the contact list., or have a resource you would like to share.*

Peer Problem Solving

We can complete these sessions remotely or face to face where requested, The purpose is to enable staff to become 'unstuck' and access support for individual pupils.

We can support schools to focus on one key area and advise on next steps.

SEMH Pupil observations

Where requested we can be an external pair of eyes, advising on areas of support within the classroom for our most vulnerable students.

Interventions with Training

We will provide a member of staff to model and deliver these interventions with a young person. Our aim is to build capacity in schools.

Intervention	Training Element
Lego in schools	Our staff will deliver therapeutic Lego sessions alongside a TA,. Time will be spent with the TA in order to plan and share resources , and answer any questions.
Thrive through art	Our staff provide art based intervention sessions and provide a pack of resources for current school staff to continue to develop with pupil/s.
Nurture Group	Our staff will support you to set up your own nurture group. We can model sessions for a period of time to support staff if required.
Peer problem solving	Our staff will lead a peer problem solving session for your school. The aim of the experience is not to guarantee a solution, but to support staff in becoming 'unstuck' and to develop a logical next step through collaboration with other professionals.
Thrive Outdoors	Our staff can provide modelled sessions on how to use Thrive in outdoor education. We can support you in delivering strategies identified in Thrive Action Plans. (SSPS can also provide Thrive Assessment and review plans)
