

Examples for our schools

Tier 1	<p>Internal school measures can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quality First Teaching • Evidence of the consistent application of the BfL procedures across the curriculum. • Active assessment of learning needs and adaptive teaching. • Internal interventions, SEND / SEMH / LM / ELSA / CPM / Tutor / etc..... 	<p>Teaching and Learning Policy Assessment Policy Behaviour for Learning Policy SEND Policy, report and local offer</p>
Tier 2	<p>Requesting additional support / signposting to local services:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attendance • SEND Outreach • Area Inclusion Panel • Family Intervention Service • SASP <p>Services are locally based and may be different in Chard / Ilminster / Yeovil</p> <p><i>Somerset Early Help and Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) Support Practitioner Guidance</i> Page 3 gives examples of when to complete an EHA</p>	<p>Referral is through the Early Help Assessment (EHA) Complete the SDQ- this provides data driven evidence, or not, of success. http://professionalchoices.org.uk/eha/</p> 
Tier 3	<p>EITHER: There is evidence that the plan, do, review cycle is not effective OR: There is a sudden, significant and visible change in behaviours.</p> <p>A referral to Tier 3 services can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PRU Outreach • SEND Outreach (children with EHCP) • CAOT • EP • Children's social care 	<p>Referral is through EHA- updated if Tier 2 interventions have been implemented.</p>
Tier 4	<p>Statutory Service</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SEND Statutory Assessment • Children's social care (CSC) • Permanent exclusion (PEX) • Hard to place (HTP) • Medical referrals • Police
